ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT

K.A.R. 115-2-2. Motor vehicle permit fees.

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> This regulation establishes daily and annual permit prices for vehicles entering and using state parks and other areas requiring a motor vehicle permit. This is a user fee for entering and using state parks. The proposed amendments would reduce all annual and daily motor vehicle permits to one-half of the current value for a period of one calendar year.

FEDERAL MANDATE: None.

ECONOMIC IMPACT: The proposed amendments may decrease revenue to the Park Fee Fund in the estimated amount of \$800,000 in FY 2007 and \$800,000 in FY 2008. The proposed amendments are the result of an increase appropriation of State General Fund earmarked specifically to replace lost revenue from a corresponding reduction in the price of motor vehicle permits. The amendments are not anticipated to have any appreciable economic impact on other agencies. .
