

## RANGE RULES and REGULATIONS

- ◇ **Rule 1:** Skydrawing is prohibited.
- ◇ **Rule 2:** No BROADHEADS allowed.
- ◇ **Rule 3:** Children under 16 must be in the company of an adult.
- ◇ **Rule 4:** Only Archery Targets can be shot. No plants or animals.
- ◇ **Rule 5:** No guns, air rifles, paintball guns, bb guns, etc. allowed.
- ◇ **Rule 6:** No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- ◇ **Rule 7:** No glass bottles.
- ◇ **Rule 8:** No pets. No Horseback riding.
- ◇ **Rule 9:** No bicycles or unauthorized motor vehicles of any kind allowed. Passenger vehicles must stay in the parking lot.
- ◇ **Rule 10:** Off trail access allowed to retrieve arrows. Stay on designated paths.
- ◇ **Rule 11:** Obey all posted signage.

The Prairie Center Archery Range was developed as a family friendly, ADA accessible (static range only) archery range designed to provide shooting opportunities for youth, their families, and practice for hunters.

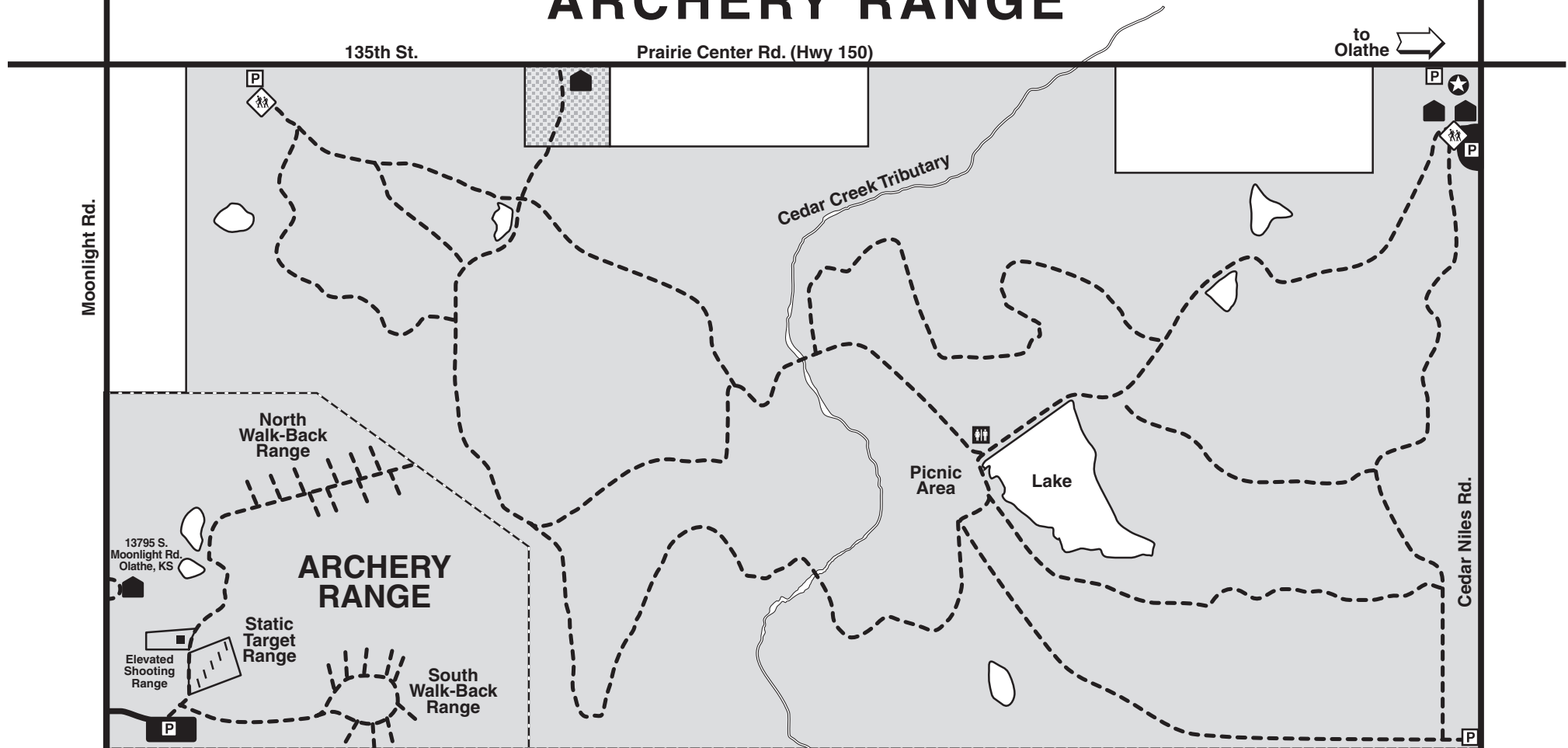
