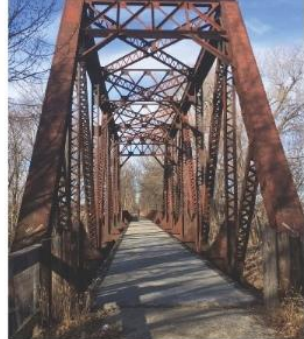


IMPROVEMENT PHASES



The Flint Hills Nature Trail is a rails-to-trails project that extends 117-miles from Osawatomie to Herington, Kansas in the right-of-way of the former Missouri Pacific Railroad (MoPac). The trail will connect six counties including Miami, Franklin, Osage, Lyon and Morris and pass through numerous communities along the way. Due to the extensive size of the trail, improvements will be completed in segments as funds become available. Phase IA is complete and Phase IB is scheduled for letting in October 2015.
