

# GREELEY

**G**reeley Wildlife Area is located ten miles north and five miles east of Tribune, in Greeley County. It was obtained in 1990 as a 50-year conservation easement to supply public hunting in an area lacking such recreation. The easement will remain in effect

until the year 2039, at which time the land will return to the heirs of the former estate.

This public hunting area consists of 900 acres of CRP grasslands and dry creek bottom flanked by native shortgrass prairie.

Ten acres of the property that make up the home site, barns, and corral are not part of the easement and are therefore not open to public hunting. Please do not trespass on this portion of the property.

## HUNTING

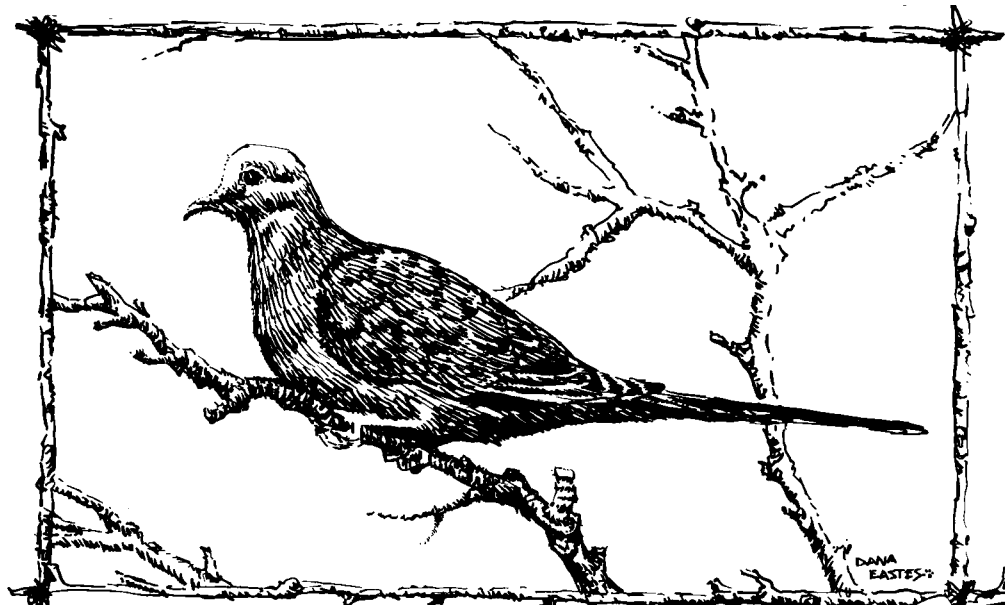
Game species that may be found on this property include white-tailed deer, mule deer, ringneck pheasant, cottontail rabbit, jackrabbit, mourning dove, and sever-

al furbearer species. Please observe written and posted regulations when using this area.

## PUBLIC-USE FACILITIES

One parking lot can be found on the southeast corner of the north portion of the property. No restrooms

or camping facilities are provided.



## THINGS TO REMEMBER

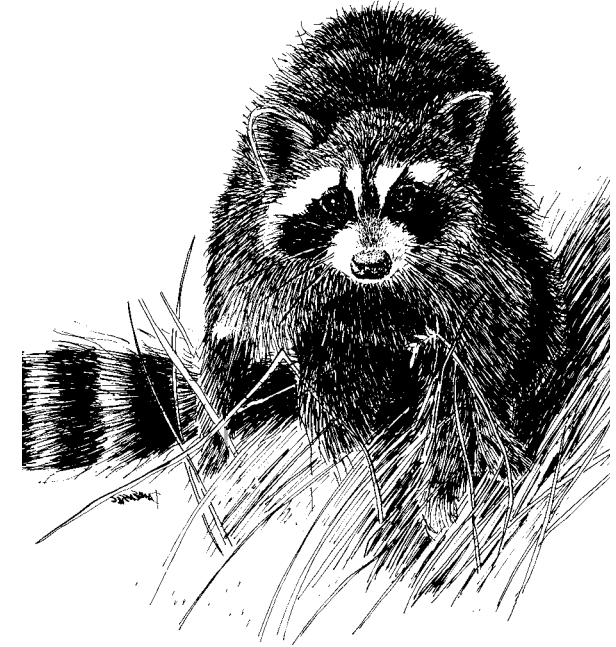
Vehicles must remain on established gravel roads or parking lots. Any two-wheel trails around the boundary of the property are private and not for public use. Off-road driving is prohibited.

General Area Map



