Change to draft regarding Moon Lake on Fort Riley Addition of Wyandotte County and alphabetizing of certain sections

As a result of the Joint Committee on Rules and Regulations comments, department comment as well as a rapidly developing opportunity with Wyandotte County Unified Government in relation to K.A.R. 115-25-14, the department suggests the following amendment be made to the version of the regulation submitted for public comment.

115-25-14. Fishing; creel limit, size limit, possession limit, and open season.

- 1. Amend proposed subsection (b) to read as follows:
- (b) Pursuant to K.A.R. 115-18-12, a trout permit shall be required to fish for and possess trout on the following waters during the specified time periods:
 - (1) October 15 through April 15:
 - (A) Webster Stilling Basin; Cedar Bluff Stilling Basin;
 - (B) Kanopolis Seep Stream; Cimarron Grasslands Pits;
 - (C) Cedar Bluff Stilling Basin; Dodge City Lake Charles;
 - (D) Lake Henry, located in Clinton State Park; Finney Refuge Sandpits;
 - (E) Scott State Fishing Lake; Fort Scott Gun Park Lake;
 - (F) Scott State Park Pond; Glen Elder State Park Pond;
 - (G) Cimarron Grasslands Pits; Great Bend Veterans Memorial Park Lake;
 - (H) Dodge City Lake Charles; Hutchinson Dillon Nature Center Pond;
 - (I) the following Sedgwick County Park waters:

(i) Moss Lake; (ii) Horseshoe Lake; (iii) Vic's Lake; and (iv) Slough Creek; Kanopolis Seep Stream; (J) Walnut River Area, located in El Dorado State Park; Kanopolis State Park Pond; (K) KDOT East Lake, located in Wichita; (L) Finney Refuge Sandpits; Lake Henry, located in Clinton State Park; (M) Salina Lakewood Lake; Moon Lake, located in Fort Riley; (N) Fort Scott Gun Park Lake; Pratt Centennial Pond; (O) Hutchinson Dillon Nature Center Pond; Salina Lakewood Lake; (P) Kanopolis State Park Pond; Scott State Fishing Lake; (Q) Glen Elder State Park Pond; Scott State Park Pond; (R) Sherman County Smoky Gardens Lake; the following Sedgwick County Park waters: (i) Moss Lake; (ii) Horseshoe Lake; (iii) Vic's Lake; and (iv) Slough Creek; (S) Great Bend Veterans Memorial Park Lake; Sherman County Smoky Gardens Lake; (T) Solomon River between Webster Reservoir and Rooks County #2 Road;

(U) Pratt Centennial Pond; Topeka Auburndale Park;

- (V) Topeka Auburndale Park; Walnut River Area, located in El Dorado State Park; and
- (W) Moon Lake, located in Fort Riley Webster Stilling Basin; and
- (X) Wyandotte County Lake.
- (2) October 15 through October 14:
- (A) Unit number 30, located in the Mined Land Wildlife Area; Tuttle Creek Reservoir Seep Stream; and
- (B) Tuttle Creek Reservoir Seep Stream Unit number 30, located in the Mined Land Wildlife Area.
