

ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT

K.A.R. 115-25-9a. Deer; open season, bag limit, and permits; additional considerations.

DESCRIPTION: The proposed new exempt regulation establishes additional considerations for the 2007-2008 firearm, muzzleloader and archery deer seasons. There are two main items in the regulation. First, the setting of Fort Riley firearms seasons occurs in the new proposed regulation in order to better accommodate the changing training mission at Fort Riley. Second, an allowance for use of game tags on designated public grounds is authorized.
