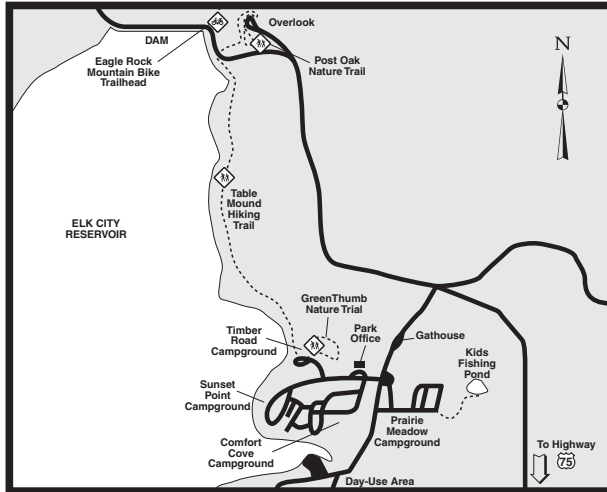


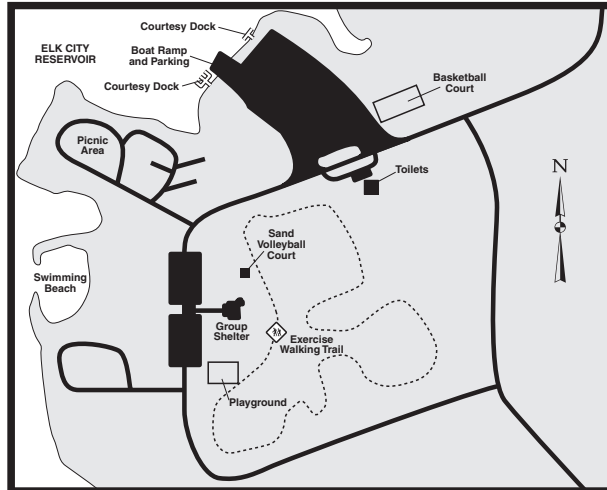

# Camping

## at Elk City State Park

Welcome to Elk City State Park! We hope that your stay here will be an enjoyable one. This was developed so that our patrons could become aware of the different areas available to them and to assist them with finding the many facilities here in the Park. Currently Elk City State Park has 11 camping sites with 3 utilities, water, electric, and sewer. 85 sites with water and electric only, and 54 primitive sites that have no utilities. Facilities include modern restrooms and showers, drinking water, swimming beach, RV sewage dump, group shelters, fishing piers, and a three-lane boat-launching ramp. See the backside for a list and location of all facilities at Elk City State Park.

Campsite reservations can be made by calling the park office and can be made for large groups. The following is a list of the sites that may be reserved.

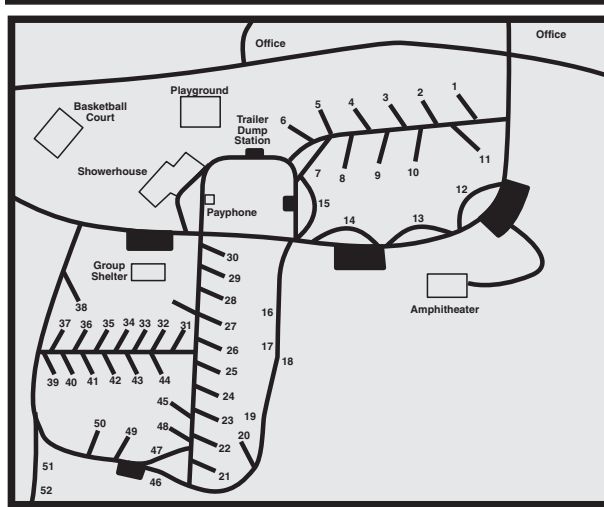

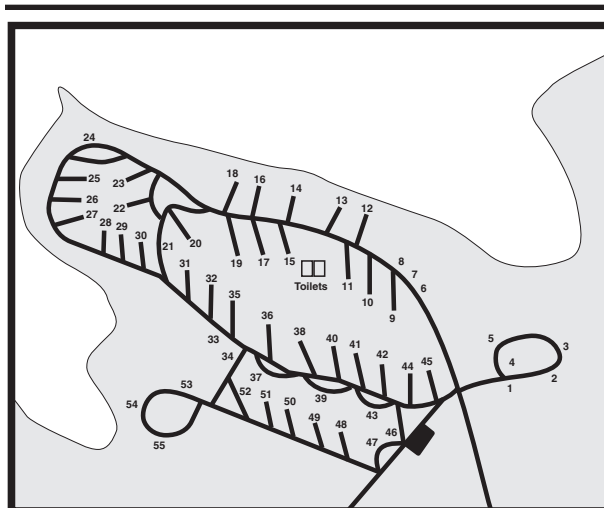

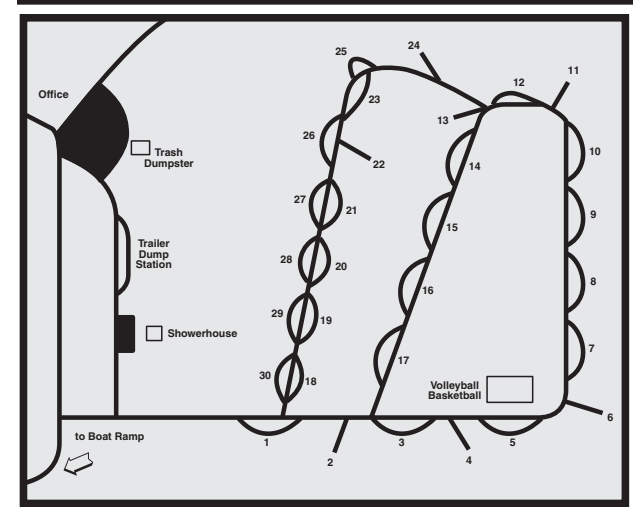
