Law Enforcement Testing Reference Guide for Study

INTRODUCTION:

The Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism Law Enforcement Division has initiated a testing procedure for applicants applying for Natural Resource Officer/Game Warden position within the division. Applicants meeting the degree requirements will be required to complete a mile run in 10 minutes. Candidates completing the run within the time limit will be tested on four major components. These components consist of: General Knowledge, Regulations, Boating Safety, and Kansas Wildlife ID. In order to reach the oral interview, these tests must be completed with the required passing score.

Good luck and strive for top honors in reaching the interview among your peers.
