

**KANSAS STATE PARK LAKE LEVEL AND BOAT RAMP STATUS
MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND, MAY 24, 2013**

Cedar Bluff Reservoir – 22 feet low; **Cedar Bluff State Park** – Overland and Muley campground boat ramps open.

Cheney Reservoir – 6.6 feet low; **Cheney State Park** – only open boat ramp is in Marina Cove.

Clinton Reservoir – 3.5 feet low; **Clinton State Park** – all boat ramps open.

Crawford State Fishing Lake – lake level is normal; **Crawford State Park** – all boat ramps open.

Toronto Reservoir – 2 feet above normal; **Cross Timbers State Park** – all ramps open.

Melvern Reservoir – 2.6 feet low; **Eisenhower State Park** – boat ramps open.

El Dorado Reservoir – 4.3 feet low; **El Dorado State Park** – most state park boat ramps are open; however, Area 1 boat ramp (east of Shady Creek Marina) and the Bolder Bluff south ramp are closed.

Elk City Reservoir – 2.6 feet above normal; **Elk City State Park** – boat ramp is open

Fall River Reservoir – 2 feet above normal; **Fall River State Park** – boat ramps are open.

Glen Elder Reservoir – 1.8 feet low; **Glen Elder State Park** – boat ramps are open

Hillsdale Reservoir – just above normal; **Hillsdale State Park** – ramps are open.

Kanopolis Reservoir – 4 feet low; **Kanopolis State Park** – boat ramp at Langley Point was partially dredged this week. A channel was opened between the boat ramp and the main lake to make it operational this weekend. Dredge work will continue next week. The Langley Point boat ramp is the only boat ramp open on the lake.

Meade State Fishing Lake – 2.5 feet low; **Meade State Park** – boat ramp open.

Lovewell Reservoir – 1 foot above normal; **Lovewell State Park** – all boat ramps are open.

Milford Reservoir – 3 feet low; **Milford State Park** – Rush Creek and South boat ramps are open. The Walnut Grove boat ramp is closed.

Perry Reservoir – 1.7 feet low; **Perry State Park** – boat ramps are open

Pomona Reservoir – 2.7 feet low; **Pomona State Park** – boat ramps 1 and 4 are open.

Keith Sebelius Reservoir – 9.7 feet low; **Prairie Dog State Park** – boat ramps are open.

Scott State Fishing Lake – lake level normal; **Scott State Park** – boat ramp is open

Tuttle Creek Reservoir – 1.8 feet above normal; **Tuttle Creek State Park** – boat ramps are open.

Webster Reservoir – 12.7 feet low; **Webster State Park** – boat ramps are open.

Wilson Reservoir – 3.7 feet low; **Wilson State Park** – boat ramps are open.
