Friday, April 29th

An afternoon of birding gets rolling with field trips led by birding tour guides that are extremely knowledgeable of Kansas Birds. Enjoy the wine and cheese reception at Tom's Taxidermy Studio in Wakefield.

Saturday, April 30th

Breakfast starts early, to ensure that you get the whole morning out to bird. There are four options on Saturday morning. The Prairie-Chicken Lek tour will leave early. The Konza Prairie tour will visit the world famous Konza Prairie Research Natural Area. The Wetlands tour will visit the wetlands and surrounding environs of Milford Lake. For those who may be interested in a less bird intense tour, join Rick Dykstra on his Back Roads Adventures! Several of these tours have very limited capacity and will be on a first-reserved, first-served basis. Saturday afternoon tours will focus on wetlands, grasslands and wooded areas.
