Temporary Position

We are looking to fill one temporary full or part time position (999 hours max.) with the potential for a second at the Sandsage Bison Range & Wildlife Area near Garden City, KS. The individual will participate in all aspects of wildlife and habitat management on the 3,670 acre Sandsage Bison Range & Wildlife Area as well as Cottonwood Flats Access Area, Hamilton State Fishing Lake & Wildlife Area (both in Hamilton County) and the Greely County Wildlife Area near Tribune. Tasks will include: tree removal with chainsaw, litter/trash removal, spraying noxious weeds and other vegetation, posting/maintaining signs, disking/planting food plots, mowing grounds, planting native grasses, building maintenance, equipment repair and maintenance, fence construction and maintenance, bison herd checks and tours to the public, water system repairs and maintenance, and other duties as assigned.

Benefits: Hourly wage \$8.00 - \$13.00/hr depending on experience, education and abilities. Normal work week will be Monday – Friday, 40 hours max/week, however, occasional week-end hours (1 or 2 hours) may be required. No paid holidays. Duration of 2 – 4 months.

Minimum Requirements: Must be physically fit and able to perform demanding tasks in a variety of outdoor settings and weather conditions. Required to be at least 18 years of age with a valid driver's license. Completion or enrollment in wildlife, fisheries or other natural resource related courses of study preferred, but not required. Interest and knowledge of terrestrial plants, wildlife and/or fisheries will be considered in candidate selections. Farm or construction experience is very helpful. Experience operating tractors, farm implements, lawn mowers, chainsaws, weed eaters, and construction tools is beneficial.
