Harvest data in conjunction with population monitoring directs more effective harvest goals and regulations. Additionally, hunter activity information increases the ability of deer managers to refine opportunities and adjust harvest goals as part of maintaining sustainable deer populations. KDWPT utilizes a post-season harvest survey to gather this data. This survey is administered once deer permit sales are summarized, so that a sample that is proportional to each permit type maybe randomly drawn. The survey period is approximately 21 days long. Participants selected for participation by email receive an initial email, and two follow up emails at one-week intervals if they have not completed the survey. Participants selected for participation by postcard receive one postcard at the beginning of the open survey period. Data summary and analysis was completed using the statistical program R.

The following summary includes information and is organized in the following order: permit sales, deer harvest by species, age, and sex, harvest by weapon type, hunter use, and deer kill on private, public and WIHA properties, season participation, hunter days afield, date of harvest, hunter satisfaction, and a summary of the special section questions. Additionally, an appendix (Appendix 1) includes estimated deer harvest by species, age, and sex for each of the 19 Deer Management Units in Kansas. An additional separate document (2018-19 Deer Harvest Survey Supplementary Material – Hunter Comments) contains all comments received through the survey as they were written, except that personal identifying information (e.g. names, phone numbers, etc.) are redacted.

This is a summary of the survey data compiled from responses of hunters completing the post-season survey. The accuracy of this summary relies on the accuracy of information provided by participants. When possible, survey responses with information that was not valid were corrected (e.g. a hunter marks one deer harvested but classifies two and the information in each classification is the same, one classification would be dropped) or removed from the dataset.

#### **Permit Sales and Survey Sample Summary**




Figure 1. Deer permit sales 2010 to present. Resident sales (orange) have declined the last three years. Non-resident sales have remained steady since most non-resident permits are limited availability through the random draw, variation in non-resident permits is typically due to changes in the number of hunt-own-land or white-tail antlerless only permits sold.

The total deer permits sold in Kansas for the 2018-19 deer season was 179,247 (Fig. 1), which is a decline of 1.85% from 2017-18 and 7.00% below the five-year average. This is the fourth year in a row that deer permit sales have declined. Most of the declines are in resident over-the-counter permits. The largest declines were in Whitetail Any Season General Resident, Whitetail Any Season Landowner/Tenant, and Whitetail Any Season Youth. Non-resident permit sales have been steady since most non-resident permits are limited availability with quotas, but slight variation occurs with Hunt-Own-Land permits.

#### Deer Permits Sold by Residency 2010-2019

Deer hunters in Kansas are limited to one permit allowing the take of an antlered deer (the buck permit; all permits allowing an antlered deer to be taken are either sex permits) and must purchase this permit before they may purchase antlerless-only permits unless they purchase antlerless only permits after December 30. During the 2018-19 deer season, hunters purchased 106,896 buck permits. A total sample size of 40,000 was drawn from hunters purchasing buck permits to receive the Kansas Deer Harvest Survey. The 40,000 hunters are sampled in proportion to the number of each type of permit sold. Thirty-two thousand hunters receive an email invitation with a weblink to participate in the survey. Eight thousand hunters are mailed a postcard with a weblink they may use to participate in the survey. Additionally, 3,500 bowhunters receive a paper form of the Deer Harvest Survey as part of participating in the Bowhunter Observation Diary, which they mail mail-in or follow the included weblink. All surveys include a hunter's KDWPT number to prevent duplicate surveys from being included as part of the results. The actual number of email invitations sent in the 2018-19 post-season was 30,249, due to incorrect emails, closed emails, etc. A total of 13,707 responses were received, made up of 12,034 responses to email invitations, 810 responses to postcards, 197 phone

responses, and 666 responses from the Bowhunter form. These responses resulted in a total of 13,562 responses with usable data for analysis and estimation of deer harvest and hunter activity for the 2018-19 deer seasons. Recent changes in international privacy law prevented surveying youth hunters under 16, therefore all youth data were included in the equivalent general resident category. There was a total of only 247 leftover non-resident permits across all non-resident permit types; due to the low sample size the non-resident permits were combined with their respective permit type issued during the non-resident draw.

#### **Statewide Deer Harvest**




Figure 2. Kansas statewide deer harvest 1965 to present. Greatest harvest occurred in 2000 (111,159) lowest harvest occurred in 1965 (1,504). The first modern deer hunting season in Kansas was held in 1965.

The 2018-19 statewide deer harvest of 81,769 an increase of 2,202 deer from the previous season's harvest. Harvest in 2018-19 was 0.88% below the three-year harvest average of 82,492 and was 5.09% below the five-year harvest average of 86,152 (Fig. 2). The 2018-19 deer harvest was the 13<sup>th</sup> highest harvest in Kansas since modern deer hunting seasons began in 1965, the highest was the 2000 season, when 111,159 deer were harvested.

Residents hunters hunted at a slightly lower rate (95.7%) than non-resident hunters (96.1%), although 95.8% of all hunters who purchased a deer permit spent time afield. Residents and non-residents had similar rates of successfully harvesting a deer. KDWPT again, for the third consecutive season, did not offer Either Species Antlerless Only permits to limit female mule deer harvest. The total mule deer harvest (1,811) was the lowest in Kansas since 1984 (1,789) although the number of antlerless mule deer harvested (214) increased from 2017-18 (139). Mule deer harvest made up 2.2% of the total deer harvest (Table 1). The total antlerless deer harvest made up 47.8% of the total deer harvest, which was slightly higher than the 2017-18 season (46.6%). Deer harvest estimates by species, sex, and age for each Deer Management Unit are included in Appendix 1.

#### Statewide Harvest by Weapon Category




Figure 3. Proportion of harvest by weapon category and proportion of harvest by sub-category within weapon category. The proportion of deer harvest by archery methods has increased while the proportion of harvest by firearms methods has decreased. The proportion of deer harvest by weapon sub-category has remained steady within the weapon categories, with the exception of crossbow and compound bow sub-categories in the archery harvest category.

A greater proportion of deer were harvested by centerfire firearms (Table 2) than any other, but compound bows were the next most popular weapon choice. Pistols were the least used method (0.18%) of harvest although shotguns with slugs (0.28%) and traditional muzzleloaders (0.50%) were also little used. As a group, muzzleloader hunters killed only 3.3% of the overall deer harvest. Archery methods were used to harvest 36.6% of the deer taken in 2018-19. Crossbow as a legal weapon for use during the archery season continues to be a contentious issue for some hunters. The proportion of the archery harvest by crossbows increased by 6.2% from 2017 to 2018, which was less than half the previous year's increase (15%) and accounts for 29.3% of deer harvested by archery methods (Fig.3).

#### **Hunter Use and Deer Harvest on Public, Private, and WIHA Properties**

Kansas has multiple types of land available for hunters to utilize. The majority of land in Kansas is under private ownership. A portion of privately-owned land is open to public hunting through the Walk-In Hunting Access Program (WIHA). During the 2017-18 deer season 1,040,000 acres was available for public hunting. There were also approximately 390,000 acres of state and federal land, much of which is specifically managed to maximize wildlife resources. The value of these publicly accessible properties to deer hunters in Kansas can be seen by the proportion of the total deer harvest that comes from those properties. Public land makes up 0.74% of land in Kansas, yet 5.79% of the total estimated deer harvest occurs on those properties (Table 3). The proportion of deer harvest on WIHA properties is 3.71%, but WIHA properties account for 1.98% of Kansas. Private property not in WIHA accounts for the remaining 97.28% of land and 90.50% of deer harvest, respectively.

Low response rate of resident youth hunting with a muzzleloader permit were combined with general residents hunting with a muzzleloader permit.

#### **Hunter Participation by Season**

During the 2018-19 deer seasons, only the muzzleloader and archery seasons had a greater than expected proportion of participation by non-residents. Of the three major seasons (muzzleloader, archery, firearms), firearms season has the greatest proportion of participation by Kansas residents at 86.5%. Seasons that limited harvest to antlerless deer, are proportionally more heavily participated in by residents. While most antlerless seasons are specific to deer management units and occur after seasons allowing antlered deer harvest; the proportion of participation in the Pre-rut season, which is available statewide, was 96.8% Kansas resident and only 3.2% non-resident. The same applies to seasons that limit participation to a specific segment of the hunter population like the designated persons season (Youth/Disabled Season) at 88.5% resident participation. A slightly greater than expected proportion of residents indicated that they did not participate in any season and didn't hunt at all.

#### **Hunter Days Afield**

During the 2018-19 deer seasons hunters in Kansas spent over 1.1 million days hunting deer (Table 5). Not including antlerless permits, residents averaged 12.0 days hunted per permit purchased, while non-residents averaged 7.4 days hunted per permit purchased. General resident and youth hunters who held a statewide archery permit hunted the most days per permit at an average 15.8 days, with resident landowner/tenants holding a statewide archery permit hunted second most averaging 15.7 days per permit. Resident landowner/tenants hunted the fewest average days per permit at 3.3 days with an Any Deer permit. Among non-residents the most days hunted were by hunters using a Hunt-Own-Land permit at an average of 10.2 days per permit, while non-residents with a whitetail either sex permit hunted on average of only 5.1 days per permit.




Figure 4. Deer Harvest by Date. Harvest is split by permit type used as either the Either Sex permit (Buck permit) and Whitetail antlerless only permit. Dates (in Year/Month/Day format) labeled on the x-axis are Saturdays during the 2018-19 season. More deer (23.4%) were harvested on Saturdays than any other day of the week, while Mondays have the least amount of harvest (6.9%). January antlerless seasons accounted for 10.2% of the deer harvest, the 12-day firearms season for 52.4%, and only 1.1% occurred during the 3-day October pre-rut antlerless season.

#### **Hunter Satisfaction**

Satisfaction of Kansas deer hunters was largely tied to whether or not they harvested a deer (Table 6). A greater number of hunters that harvested a deer also completed the satisfaction portion of the survey. In general, hunters harvesting a deer displayed greater satisfaction rates than those that did not. Non-residents were also likely to display greater satisfaction than residents.

#### **Special Section**

#### Hunter Preferences for January Antlerless Season Structure

The 2018-19 Kansas Deer Harvest Survey asked hunters for their satisfaction with current January Whitetail Antlerless Only (WAO) season opening day and length structure. We used the potential for conflict index (Manfredo et al. 2003) to evaluate deer hunters' satisfaction with the opening date and season length by Deer Management Unit because DMUs have varying season lengths in January depending on deer population size estimates and goals.




Figure 5. Potential for conflict index for January Whitetail Antlerless Only season opening date by deer management unit. January 1 has been the opening date for all DMUs. The mean satisfaction in a DMU is greater the further above zero a dot is located. The further below zero a dot is located indicates greater mean dissatisfaction. Dot size indicates potential for conflict around the mean, larger dots show more potential for conflict which indicates answers were more extreme in satisfaction or dissatisfaction.

Hunters in general were satisfied with the opening date of January 1 (Fig. 5) although the units with the most potential for conflict and lowest average satisfaction were DMUs that have had only a single day for January antlerless seasons. DMUs with the longest January season lengths were the most satisfied with the date of opening day and most hunters answered the same way as indicated by low potential for conflict index values.




Figure 6. Potential for conflict index for January Whitetail Antlerless Only season length by deer management unit. January 1 has been the opening date for all DMUs. The mean satisfaction in a DMU is greater the further above zero a dot is located. The further below zero a dot is located indicates greater mean dissatisfaction. Dot size indicates potential for conflict around the mean, larger dots show more potential for conflict which indicates answers were more extreme in satisfaction or dissatisfaction.

Hunters, except those in DMUs with only a single day January WAO season, were mostly satisfied with their current season length (Fig. 6). Hunters in DMUs with only a single day January WAO season were on average dissatisfied with the season length in the DMU the hunt most in. Also, hunters in DMUs with one day seasons also showed the most potential for conflict indicating they answered more in the extremes of satisfaction or dissatisfaction. Again, hunters in DMUs with the longest January WAO seasons had the most homogenous answers.




Figure 7. Percent of respondents preferring different options for opening date of Kansas January whitetail antlerless only seasons. Options included where continuing with the current opening date of January 1, opening on the first Friday in January, opening on the first Saturday in January, and no preference.

We asked hunters to select their choice from among different options for opening dates for the January WAO seasons. The options we asked about were keeping the current Jan. 1 opener, opening the season on the first Friday in January, opening the season on the first Saturday, or they did not have a preference. Most hunters indicated they preferred keeping the current Jan. 1 opening day (Fig. 7), and the next largest group was those hunters who had no preference.





Figure 8. Percent of respondents preferring different options for structure of Kansas January whitetail antlerless only seasons. Options included were always including at least one weekend in the shortest season, seasons were always a set number of days regardless of weekends, no preference and the current structure that includes a weekend in the shortest season only if the season length would be less than 5 days otherwise the season is one day.

We asked hunters to select their choice in January season structure also. The options we asked hunters to pick from included the current structure in which the shortest season would run through the first Sunday in January unless doing so would include more than four days upon which the season would only be Jan. 1; always including a weekend in the shortest season and an additional weekend for each increase in the season length; season lengths that were a set number of days (e.g. 5, 10, 15 or 4, 8, 12 days) and no preference. Hunters selected no preference (Fig. 8) at the highest rate but nearly the same percentage selected always having a weekend in the shortest season.


