Furbearers and coyotes; legal equipment, taking methods, and general provisions. POSSIBLE AMENDMENT

At the request of Commissioner Sill, the Department has drafted the following amendment for possible amendment to the version of the regulation submitted for public comment.

K.A.R. 115-5-1. Furbearers and coyotes; legal equipment, taking methods, and general provisions.

- 1. Amend proposed subsection (d)(1) on page 5 as follows in bold italic type:
- (d) From January 1 through March 31, the following provisions shall apply to the hunting of coyotes:
- (1) Artificial light, scopes and equipment that amplify visible light, and thermal-imaging scopes and thermal-imaging equipment may be used for hunting (by individuals 18 years of age and older).
- (2) The use of vehicles when hunting with the equipment specified in paragraph (d)(1) shall be prohibited.
- (3) The use of the equipment specified in paragraph (d)(1) shall not be authorized on department lands and waters.
- (4) Each person using the equipment specified in paragraph (d)(1) in the manner prescribed in this subsection shall first obtain a permit from the department.
