Conservation Technician – Two (2) Open Positions

These temporary positions are in the Fisheries and Wildlife Division at the Farlington Fish Hatchery, and are directly supervised by Dan Mosier II, Hatchery Manager. These positions are for the 2022 production season.

The incumbent will be involved in all facets of hatchery operation. Job duties include, but are not limited to: fish feeding, fish harvest, fish distribution, grounds maintenance, building maintenance, vehicle maintenance, data collection, and public tours. The successful candidates will also provide assistance to Fisheries Biologist II's on special projects. **Weekend work may be required.**

One full time temporary position will run from mid-March through August and the other from mid-May through October. Positions are limited to 999 hours or less for the calendar year. Position dates may be flexible depending on candidate availability, for example a position starting in mid-May and ending in mid-August.

BENEFITS: Hourly wage of \$11.00, limited to 40 hours per week. No paid holidays. No benefits.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Ability and willingness to perform physical labor (repeated lifting of 50 pounds) in an outdoor setting in all types of weather. Valid driver's license. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older. Familiarity with operation of power tools, hand tools, tractors, mowers and heavy trucks preferred. A preference will be given to those working toward or having natural resources degree.
