Measurement Instructions: Turkey must be weighed on accurate scales and verified by two witnesses. All measurements must be recorded to the nearest eighth of an inch. Each beard is measured at the point of protrusion from the skin to the end of the longest bristle. Each spur is measured to its longest straight or curved length from a point where the hard spur protrudes from the scaled leg skin. The total score is arrived at by adding the weight to the sum of the beard lengths multiplied by two and the sum of the spur lengths multiplied by ten. Separate records will be kept for typical and non-typical gobblers. A gobbler is non-typical if it has multiple beards or spurs. Gobbler must be taken in Kansas. A minimum of 65 points is required to qualify.
